Development Services Update #18-05

As the building and development permit issue continues to be a priority for the department. This notice is intended to provide a public update about processing timelines and staffing capacity in the Development Services Department.

- ⇒ Complete building inspection services are available 5 days per week, utilizing Outwest Building Inspection Consultants, a company which provides inspections and plan reviews on behalf of the City.
- ⇒ During the week of June 4, 16 building inspections including several complex, new home inspections occurred.
- ⇒ Building permit reviews this week were lower than expected due to a prioritization of inspecting active construction. Readjustment of priorities are planned for the week of June 11.
- ⇒ Additional plan reviews with a second building inspector are scheduled for the coming weeks which will assist in reducing the backlog of permit issuance, as both plans reviews and building inspections will occur.

What are the next steps:

- ⇒ Permits waiting for review for new home construction and major renovations are being prioritized.
- ⇒ The recruitment/hiring process for qualified in-house building inspectors is ongoing. The City has budgeted for and the goal is to hire two building inspectors.

What builders & contractors can do:

- ⇒ Please contact Development Services to book your required inspections.
- ⇒ Do not cover any construction work. All construction <u>must</u> be inspected by a designated City official. e.g. do not backfill footings, or cover vapour barrier with drywall etc. please call and book an inspection.
