

GENERAL USER EXPECTATIONS

The City of Revelstoke is responding to the direction to reopen our facilities and services to the community cautiously, with the safety of staff and the community being the priority. Accordingly, these are our prevention protocols we have put in place during the COVID-19 pandemic and it is your responsibility to follow these guidelines while attending Municipal Facilities. These protocols are subject to change at any time.

Screening:

Monitor your and your family's health before you attend:

- ⇒ If you or anyone in your household has any cold/flu or COVID-19 symptoms within the past 10 days, DO NOT attend.
- ⇒ This also applies if you have to self-isolate due to arriving from outside Canada within the past 14 days or have had contact with someone confirmed to have COVID-19 or have been directed by public health to self-isolate.

Physical Distancing:

- ⇒ 2 metre physical distancing in place at all times.
- ⇒ No socializing or gathering, in lobby area, washrooms, or parking lot, before, during or after your visit to the facility.
- ⇒ If visiting the facility for a meeting or program, please arrive 5 minutes prior to the event and leave the facility immediately after (including the parking lot).

Hand Hygiene:

- ⇒ Hand sanitization is mandatory upon arriving / leaving.
- ⇒ Cough and sneeze into your sleeve.
- ⇒ Avoid touching your face.
- ⇒ Do not share equipment.

General:

- ⇒ Be respectful and mindful of others using the facility.
- ⇒ In accordance with public health orders, masks are mandatory in the facility.
- ⇒ No spitting anywhere on the premise.
- ⇒ Please comply with facility and program protocols.
