## REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

### DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

#### GRIZZLY PLAZA

Council received the results of the Fall 2021 community questionnaire and directed staff to engage a Steering Committee to review and advise on community engagement for refurbishment and revitalization of Grizzly Plaza.

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#### BC HOUSING - 420 DOWNIE ST

Council gave first and second readings to Bylaws 2311 and 2312 to rezone the property to facilitate a mixed-use development and directed staff to schedule a Public Hearing for this application.

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### COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

#### RECOVERY TASK FORCE UPDATE

Council gave direction to provide relief to businesses obtaining permits for the use of sidewalks for patios and retail sales.

#### KOA CAMPGROUND OWNERSHIP MODEL CHANGE

Council deferred their consideration of conversion of the ownership structure for a portion of the Revelstoke KOA Campground to a cooperative interest ownership model until the March Committee of the Whole Meeting.

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#### JORDAN RIVER SECTION 17 CONDITIONAL WITHDRAWAL

Council received information confirming the City's successful bid to have the Province withdraw a portion of Crown Lands from disposition for a 10 year period in the interest of environment, conservation and recreation.

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
