ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

COUNCIL SUPPORT FOR SUBMISSION OF UBCM GRANT APPLICATION

Council approved the submission of a request to UBCM for grant funding for the continuation of an emergency shelter pilot program operated by Community Connections Revelstoke Society
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ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FUNDING

Council made several recommendations to the Columbia Shuswap Regional District Board regarding allocation of funding to support core administration costs for Community Economic Development, Implementation of a Destination Management Plan, Ski Shuttle Service, and to facilitate industry sector development planning

Council Adopted Bylaws No. [2305](#) (Business Licensing), [2306](#) (Municipal Ticket Information) and [2307](#) (Fees & Charges) to allow for the regulation of business operations and enforcement measures related to Short Term Rentals

REVELSTOKE FORUM/LIQUOR PRIMARY LICENSE

Council authorized the Revelstoke Grizzlies Hockey Society to apply for an event driven, permanent liquor primary license as the primary license holder for the Revelstoke Forum, with all costs associated with licensing to be borne by the Revelstoke Grizzlies Hockey Society.
