The City of Revelstoke and General Assembly: First Street & Grizzly Plaza Water Main Construction Work

Revelstoke, B.C – This summer, the City of Revelstoke will continue the construction of the Water Main Replacement and Rehabilitation Program.

In 2023, contractors for the City of Revelstoke completed a portion of the First Street Water Main Replacement Project, identified in the City's [Water Master Plan](#) (2022). Last year, the Pearson Avenue to Rokeby Avenue section was completed. This year, from late April through June, the contractors will work on the remaining portion of this project, focusing on Rokeby Avenue to Mackenzie Avenue and the intersections to the north and south of Grizzly Plaza.

While the schedule and traffic plans are still in the works, the intention is to complete the construction block-by-block so that the full street length and width need not close for the entirety of the project. Closer to the construction start date the contractor, General Assembly, will issue construction notices with more information to affected residents/businesses.

Key Notes:

- Parking may be limited during this work. The City encourages residents and guests to utilize the public transit system. More information about public transport can be found at revelstoke.ca/Transit.
- On-street use such as patios, events and parking may be affected during this project.
- Local traffic and pedestrians are expected to have access.
- The Parks, Recreation and Culture Team has informed upcoming Event Managers of the disruption so that they may make alternative arrangements.
- The City of Revelstoke will provide regular updates regarding road closures via the City's social media channels and bi-weekly City Views newsletter during the project.
