Join the City of Revelstoke for your Neighbourhood’s Zoning ‘Coffee Chat’

Revelstoke, B.C – Throughout April, the City of Revelstoke will host educational sessions on the ‘Zoning Bylaw Comprehensive Rewrite Project’ and its pending updates. These sessions will run on a neighbourhood-by-neighbourhood basis to allow you the chance to ask questions specific to your property.

The first major milestone of the ‘Zoning Bylaw Comprehensive Rewrite Project’ is complete, and the ‘Drafting New Zones and New Zoning Map’ is available in draft form for public review. **Zoning impacts every property owner in Revelstoke** and, as the rules have been updated, the City wants to help property owners understand the upcoming changes. **Interested residents are encouraged to [review the zoning bylaw changes in advance](#)** so that you can utilize this opportunity to ask specific questions about your property.

What is zoning? Zoning spells out the rules for what type of development is permitted on a resident’s property, whether they can subdivide, and what density/height they’re permitted to build.
