ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2387

Council gave First, Second and Third Readings and adopted Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2387. The land will be rezoned from the CSRD Bylaw 851 Rural Residential 2-hectare Zone (RR2) to the City's Single and Two Family Residential Zone (R2), and another portion to Residential Tourist Accommodation 1 Zone (RTA-1).
