BUSINESS LICENSING AND REGULATIONS AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2398

If approved, businesses will have an additional 30-day grace period to pay the renewal fees before any late penalties are accrued (put forward by staff in an effort to acknowledge that the holiday season can be a busy time for the business community and reduce the pressure on the City’s Finance department).
