FEES & CHARGES AMENDMENT BYLAW NO. 2399

Council read the Fees & Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 2399 a First, Second and Third time. The bylaw shows an average increase of 6% to ensure the City can continue providing its current level of service amidst increased costs.

FINANCE

2025 DRAFT BUDGET

Council approved that the Financial Plans be circulated for public feedback :

- Property taxes: base increase to cover service levels plus multiple scenarios for the arena rehabilitation reserve fund. For example, a 7% increase (of which 3% would be directly for the arena rehabilitation reserve fund)
- Garbage rates: 10% increase
- Water User rates: 5% increase
- Big Eddy Water User rates: 5% increase
- Sewer User Rates & Sewer Frontage Charges: 5% increase

2. THAT the Financial Plans, including the Operating and Capital/Major Project Spending Packages, be presented for public feedback.

3. THAT two public engagement sessions be scheduled for Thursday, November 28, at the Community Centre.
