2025 Property Tax Notices Mailed Ahead of Schedule – Deadline Remains July 2

Revelstoke, B.C – Due to the potential Canada Post strike tentatively scheduled for the end of May, the City of Revelstoke mailed out 2025 Property Tax Notices ahead of schedule to ensure residents receive their notice and make the July 2 deadline.

In the event of a Canada Post strike, the due date for property tax payments, Wednesday, July 2, will not change. As such, the City encourages residents to avoid mailing payments. To ensure payments are received on time, property owners are encouraged to use one of the following payment options:

- Through their financial institution
- In-person at City Hall by cash, cheque or debit
- Online at "rvst.ca/payonline" using OptionPay
