A zoning bylaw amendment to rezone subject lands at Boyle Avenue from MU-1 to MU-2 to recognize an existing legal non-conforming use (single-detached dwelling) so that an addition can be constructed was given three readings then Adopted. The bylaw aligns with applicable Official Community Plan policies.
