### MANUFACTURED HOME PARKS POLICY AMENDMENTS

Staff will prepare amendments to the 'Manufactured Home Park Redevelopment, Residential Tenant Protection and Strata Conversion Policy (DS-24)' to strengthen protections for existing manufactured home park residents by minimizing the likelihood of displacement. These amendments will be shared at the September Committee of the Whole meeting.

### DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATION DP2025-009

Council approved Revelstoke Mountain Resort's Development Permit Application DP2025-009 for the development of a multi-unit dwelling with a total of 43-units with a mix of 1-3 bedrooms on Nichol Road.

### BIG BEND SANITARY SEWER UPGRADE AND LATECOMERS COST SHARING AGREEMENT

The City of Revelstoke will enter a cost-sharing agreement with Basecamp Resorts (based on usage) to initiate the Big Bend Sanitary Sewer Upgrade Project. Council approved that any future developments wishing to benefit from the upgraded system will need to enter into a latecomers' agreement to contribute a proportionate share of the cost.
