COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

RESORT DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY (RDS) 2025- 2027

As one of 14 Resort Municipality communities, Revelstoke is required to submit a RDS for the period 2025 to 2027 in accordance with the program guidelines provided by the Ministry of Tourism, Arts and Culture.

Capital projects identified in the RDS 2025-2027 include:

- Additional connector multi-use pathways linking Columbia Park with the downtown core
- Required maintenance and upgrades to City-owned shuttle buses
- Phase 3 of the Wayfinding Signage Strategy
- Planned expenditures on City infrastructure including development of a fenced dog park and pump track.
- Funds allocated to recreation, arts and culture groups for infrastructure projects
- Additional funding for Revy Live Outside
- Additional funding for summer shuttle services
- Ambassador program funding

BC TRANSIT ANNUAL OPERATING AGREEMENT AND TRANSIT EXPANSION PLAN

The Annual Operating Agreement and Transit Expansion Plan for Transit Services with BC Transit was approved for 2025-2026. The City will continue to partner with BC Transit and Interior Health to provide transit services. This includes fixed route paratransit, handyDART, taxiDART and Health Connections to Kamloops and Kelowna. As part of the agreement, BC Transit contracts Revelstoke Connections Ltd. to deliver these services.
