COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

Both Public Infrastructure Committee (PIC) recommendations were approved:

1. The underground Fourth Street works will continue, while above-ground works have been deferred until BC Housing is ready to start its project.
2. Staff will initiate a program to revise posted speed limits on Collector Roads to 40km/hr and local roads to 30km/hr.
