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FIRE

FIRE AND SECURITY ALARMS REGULATION AMENDMENT BYLAW

The Regulation of False Alarms in Respect of Fire and Security Alarm Systems Amendment Bylaw No. 2429 was adopted.

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FINANCE

FEES AND CHARGES

Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 2256 was adopted by Council. It will take effect on January 1, 2026.

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PLANNING SERVICES

DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE APPLICATION PERMIT

Council denied the Development Variance Permit for 3127 Camozzi Road as it would have increased the scale of the operations in a manner that is contrary to the intent of the applicable zoning.

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SHORT-TERM RENTAL PROJECT

Staff will bring the Short-Term Rental Project, including draft scenarios and housing impact analysis, to the public for feedback.

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OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN AMENDMENT BYLAW

Council gave Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 2432 and Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2433 First reading, authorized staff to pursue consultation with internal City Departments, Interior Health, BC Hydro, RCMP, Telus, and Fortis BC and approved scheduling a Public Hearing in 2026. .

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BILL 44

The report related to "Bill 44 Official Community Plan Compliance" was approved for submission to Province to demonstrate compliance with the requirements for Official Community Plans and Zoning Bylaws.

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OAP TACTICAL PLAN

The Municipal and Regional District Tax 2026 Affordable Housing Plan that outlines how the City intends to use the Online Accommodation Platform (OAP) funding for affordable housing initiatives was approved.

PLANNING SERVICES

ZONING AMENDMENT BYLAW

Council read Bylaw No. 2430 a First and Second time to change zoning of 3025 Camozzi Road from Low Density Residential – Rural Residential Zone (R-LD7) to Low Density Residential – Ground-Oriented Dwelling Zone (R-LD1) which allows for minimum lot area of 370 m2 (which would support future subdivision potential).

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BYLAW NO.2428 TO REPEAL HOUSING AGREEMENT BYLAWS

Council adopted Bylaw No. 2428 to Repeal Housing Agreement Bylaws No. 2276 and 2410.

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COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

REVELSTOKE AIRPORT REVIEW

Staff are to explore three options related to ownership of the Revelstoke airport including advocating the CSRD (current owner) for improvements and purchasing the airport. Staff were authorized to research grant opportunities for an Airport Master Plan will be established for the airport, and to fund further planning and required maintenance.

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MUNICIPAL AND REGIONAL DISTRICT TAX ANNUAL PLAN

The Municipal and Regional District Tax 2026 Annual Tactical Plan and Budget was approved.

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
