This month Bylaw Enforcement saw an increase of 50 calls for service for the month of November when compared to last year. The majority of increases stem from Traffic & Highway and Animal Control complaints.

Traffic Control will continue to be the major focal point of Bylaw Enforcement for the winter season as parking complaints reach the peak during heavy snow fall.

Another focus for Bylaw Enforcement has been the increase of complaints of campers parking and camping overnight on City streets, Bylaw, the Fire Department, and RCMP are all aware of the situation and are working to gain compliance.
