



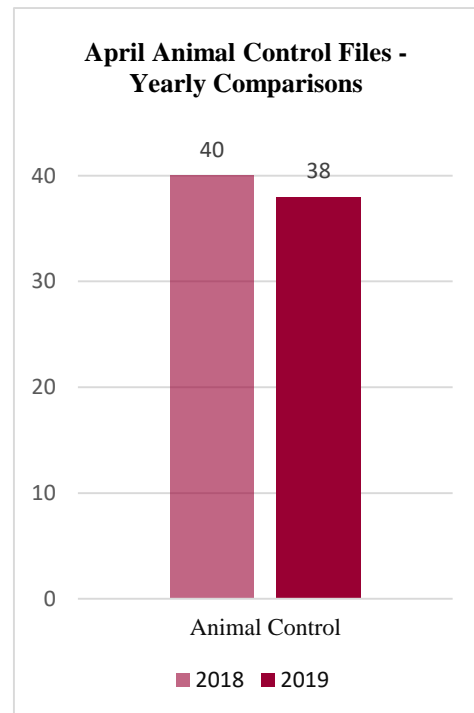
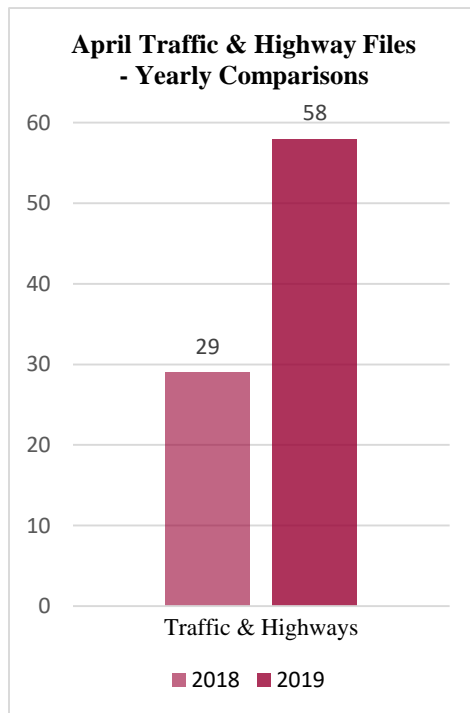

April Bylaw of the Month – Municipal Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 2185.

- The focus of this month was education, with emphasis on approved uses, regulations, and rules for the safe use of our City parks.
- Helpful tips from the Bylaw were listed on the website via the Bylaw of the Month page to inform residents and visitors of the current rules such as: no liquor, no camping, no motor vehicles, requirements for Special Event Permits and a reminder for off leash dogs and dog waste.
