

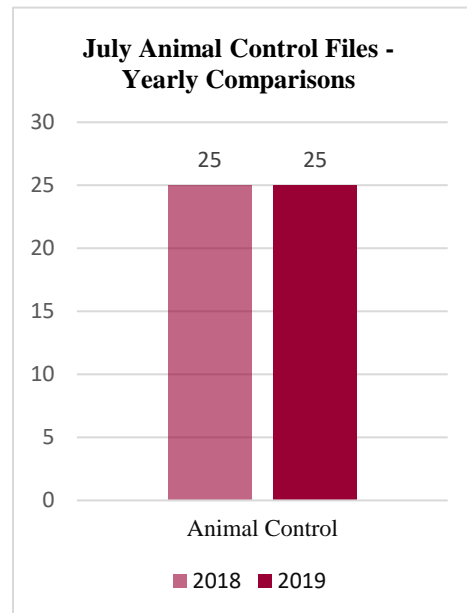
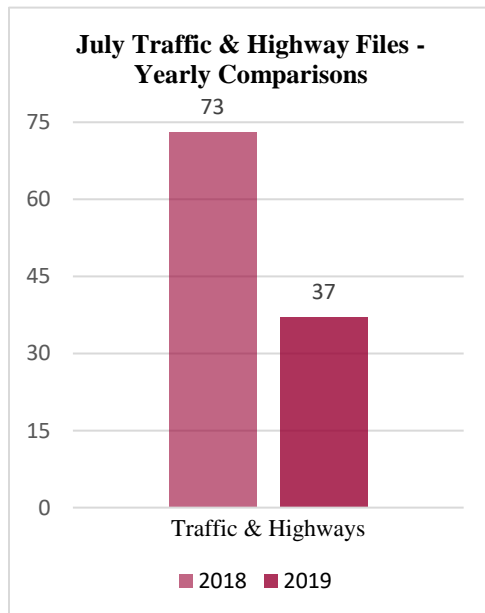

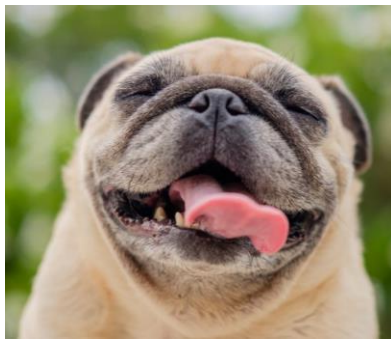

#### July Bylaw of the Month – Watering Bylaw No. 1940:

- The focus of this month was education, with emphasis on watering hours and days, exemptions and fines associated with not following the watering regulations.
- The Administration and Bylaw Enforcement Department created watering violation forms for Public Works staff to fill out when they see a watering infraction. Staff also updated the watering brochure to include watering exemptions.
