Regular Council Meeting - Tuesday, December 10th, 2019

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DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

- **Development Variance Permit – 902 Eighth Street** – Council approved a variance to reduce the front yard setback to bring an existing home into conformance and allow new construction within the same setback. View the [Report](#) / [Attachment](#).
- **Development Permit & Development Variance Permit – 1004 Oscar Street** – Council approved a development permit for form & character with a variance to the side yard setback and the height of a proposed Revelstoke Community Housing Society 24 unit affordable rental apartment. - **Development Variance Permit – 800 Third Street West** – Council approved a variance to reduce the side yard setback from 3m to 1.71m to legalize an existing non-conforming house and garage addition. View the [Report](#) / [Attachment](#).

DEPARTMENTAL BUDGET DISCUSSIONS

BYLAWS

- **Commercial Vehicle Licensing Repeal Bylaw No. 2252** – A Commercial Vehicle Licensing Program administered by UBCM no longer meets its original intent making Commercial Vehicle Licensing Bylaw No. 740 no longer valid. Council gave the first 3 readings to a bylaw to repeal Bylaw 740. [Report](#) / [Attachment](#).
- **Official Community Plan Amendment Bylaw No. 2249 and Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2250** – The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure advised that Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 2250 does not impact operations. Council adopted Bylaw 2249 and 2250. [OCP Bylaw](#) / [Zoning Text Amendment TUP](#) / [MoTI Letter – Bylaw 2250](#).
- **Delegation Amendment Bylaw No. 2255** – Council adopted [Bylaw 2255](#) which will help expedite subdivision applications by giving the Approving Officer regulatory authorization.
- **Fees & Charges Bylaw No. 2256** – No public comments were received regarding the proposed changes to fees. Council adopted Bylaw No. 2256. View the [Report](#) / [Bylaw](#).
