BYLAWS

- **Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 2240 for Phase I Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrade**— Council needs to provide a resolution authorizing a loan for a portion (26.67%) of project costs to ensure the City's application for funding is considered. View the [Report](#) / [Bylaw](#).

COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- **Resort Shuttle Amended Partnering Agreement** — The existing partnering agreement to run the Resort Shuttle was amended with a revised contribution amount and a revised Schedule C listing the busses in operation. View the [Report](#) / [Attachment](#).
- **Wayfinding Strategy**— [The Resort Development Strategy](#) included the implementation of new wayfinding signage that aligns with tourism branding. Stakeholders met on a number of occasions to create a final draft of the [Signage and Wayfinding Program](#) including a Phasing Plan. - **Climate Change Mitigation** — Council approved moving forward with an update to the Community Energy Emissions Plan (CEEP) and Corporate Energy and Greenhouse Gas Emission Inventory and Reduction Strategy plus integration of the BC Energy Step Code into the Revelstoke Building Bylaw. - **BC Active Transportation Grants** — Council approved submission of two grant applications to support bicycle transportation in the City: An Active Transportation Network Grant application to support development of framework for transportation infrastructure which will encourage a connected, safe and affordable community AND Active Transportation Infrastructure Grant application for four new, safe bike rack locations.
