Victoria/Townley & Fourth Roundabout Project Start-Up Set for April 27th

Revelstoke, BC – The City of Revelstoke is excited to announce that Eagle Rock Construction is expected to start work on the roundabout project on Monday April 27th, 2020. The complete project includes a roundabout at the existing intersection of Victoria Road, Townley Street and Fourth Street East, as well as repairs to underlying sewer and water utilities.



The City of Revelstoke is extremely grateful to UBCM for their financial support through the Federal Gas Tax Program – [Strategic Priorities Fund](#). The addition of the roundabout will improve the flow of traffic for all modes of transportation through a challenging intersection and aims to address safety issues, reduce crash frequency and severity in what is currently the City's top, non-highway, collision intersection.

The roundabout will be a great addition for our community providing a safe solution to a problem intersection" commented Mayor Gary Sulz. "I am thrilled to see this grant funded project combine construction with improvements to existing infrastructure".
