On May 12, 2020, City of Revelstoke Council supported establishment of a **Recovery Task Force (RTF)** in collaboration with the CSRD.

*The **PURPOSE** of the Recovery Task Force is to identify immediate and long-term needs, assess various initiatives, and craft a response to the economic disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic that best serve the needs of the local community.*

WHO WE ARE

Intended to be a non-partisan, multi-sectoral ‘think-tank’, the Recovery Task Force is a collaborative effort led by the City of Revelstoke Community Economic Development (CED) department in collaboration with the Revelstoke Chamber of Commerce/Visitor Centre, Community Futures, Tourism Revelstoke, and select industry/social sector representatives.

Short Term:

- Mackenzie Avenue Street Pilot Project - a phased approach to support Revelstoke’s historic and vibrant downtown economy.
