

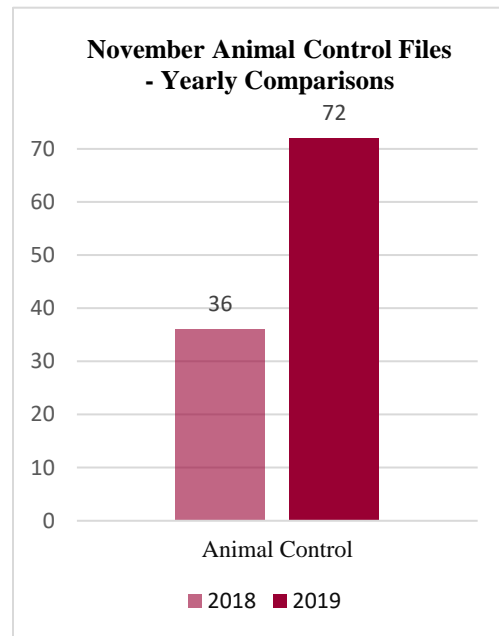
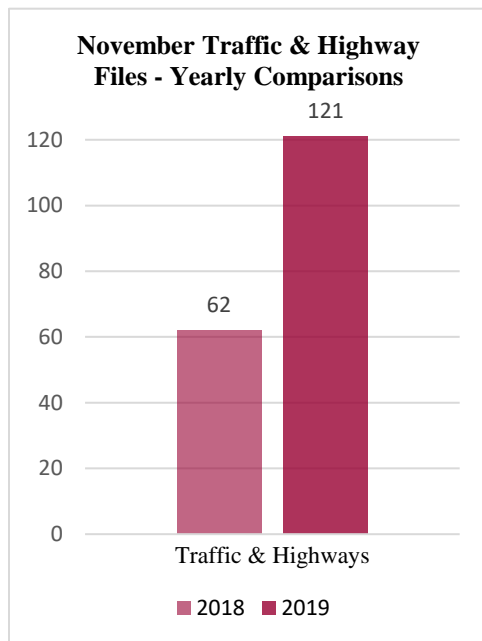

### Dogs Impounded/Returned This Month:

- Bylaw Enforcement impounded 3 dogs this month.
- Tickets were issued for dog at large and no dog license.

### Results of the Animal Control Compliance Campaign:

Officers began the campaign in October spending several weeks focusing on education which included patrols of popular dog walking areas, distribution of brochures, radio ads, social media posts, online advertising and a discussion during the Mayor's weekly radio show. Officers noted the following successes:

- Improved compliance after education period
- Increased issuance of dog licenses from October 1<sup>st</sup> to November 30<sup>th</sup>
  - 38 new lifetime and 4 annual, an increase from 11 dog licenses issued in the same time frame in 2018.

During the education phase of the campaign, Officers issued warnings with an opportunity to comply prior to ticketing. Verbal warnings for the first 14 days of the campaign included:

- Aggressive Dogs x 2
- Dog at Large x 65
- Not on Leash x 22

Staff anticipated an increase in Animal Control tickets; however, because of the success of the education phase Officers issued only 13 MTI tickets; when compared to the same dates last year 7 tickets were issued.
