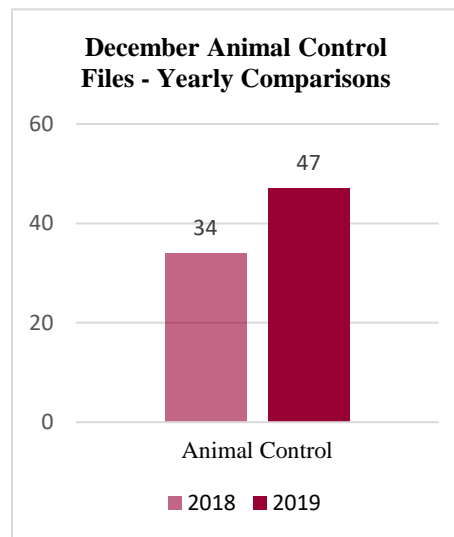
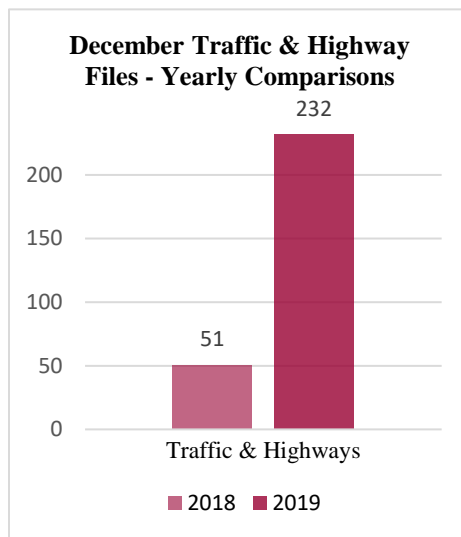

December's Bylaw of the Month, Winter-Traffic & Highways Bylaw No. 1400

- The focus for December was parking in the winter. This campaign aimed to help address winter parking issues that can create unsafe roads conditions for drivers and pedestrians. Bylaw of the month was feature in radio ads to help prevent such things as obstruction of snow removal, impeding a cross walk and parking at a yellow curb.

Additional Notes:

- Bylaw Enforcement continues to see an increase with Traffic and Highways issues for the month of December. Including, working to remind and ticket vehicles that are obstructing snow removal.
- Bylaw continues to work towards compliance for Animal Control issues.
- Bylaw received 42 Aggressive/Dangerous Dog calls for 2019 versa 37 Aggressive Dangerous Dog calls in 2018.
- Calls for Bylaw service for the year have increased by 46% from 1432 calls in 2018 to 2090 calls in 2019.
